Creating the World: Days 1 & 2

Lesson Aim: To know God created
the heavens and the earth.

THE WELCOME TREASURE CHEST

CENTERS

- COLORING CENTER: Days 1 & 2
- PLAY-DOUGH CENTER: God Created the Earth
- BLOCK CENTER: God Made the World
- DRAMATIC PLAY CENTER: Night and Day

THE WORSHIP THE GOD WHO CREATES

Say hello to each child, calling them by name. If they aren't in the worship area, call them over by name. **I'm so glad to see you today. Who created the world?** (God.) **That's right, God created the world and everything in it. Let's pray to our great God.** Have the children bow their heads and close their eyes. **Dear God, we praise You for the world You have created. Amen.**

Sing the Bible Memory Verse Song and other related songs.

OFFERING: Collect the offering.

WORSHIP ILLUSTRATION: *The Adventures of Delbert & Lello* puppet script or storybook

BIBLE MEMORY VERSE: Practice Bible Memory Verse with the motions. "In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth." Genesis 1:1

THE WORD GOD CREATED THE HEAVENS AND THE EARTH CLASSROOM PROMISE

Place the Creation Box in your lap or on a table next to you. **Today, we are going to begin learning about the creation of the world. To create something, means to make it. Who made the world?** (God.) Point to the Creation Box. **This is our Creation Box. It's going to help us remember all the things God made.** Remove the

flashlight from the box and turn it on. **The flashlight reminds us of the first day of creation when God created day and night.** If you have time, allow each child to have a turn turning the flashlight on and off. Remove the water bottle from the box. **On the second day, God separated the water and the sky. Do you know what He said when He was done? He said it was good. Let's listen to our story.** Handle Bible as a special treasure, leaving it open to Genesis 1:1.

WATCH THE WORD: GENESIS 1:1-8

Read poem. Display visual.

- **In the beginning God did create**
- **The heavens and the earth.**
- **Then God said, "Let there be light,"**
- **God saw it was good. And He was right.**
- **Then God called the light, "day."**
- **He called the darkness, "night."**
- **That was the first day and night.**
- **On the second day, He made the sky!**

Who created the heavens and the earth? (God.) **When He saw His creation, He saw it was good. Was He right?** (Yes.) **Yes, everything that God created was good.**

Creating the World: Days 3 & 4

Lesson Aim: To know how God filled
the heavens and the earth.

THE WELCOME TREASURE CHEST

CENTERS

- COLORING CENTER: Days 3 & 4
- PLAY-DOUGH CENTER: Night Sky
- DRAMATIC PLAY CENTER: Plants to Eat
- ACTIVITY CENTER: Creation Box

THE WORSHIP THE GOD WHO CREATES

The word “create” means to make something. What did God create? Let’s thank God for all the things He created. Have the children bow their heads and close their eyes. **Dear God, thank You for all the amazing things You created. I especially thank You for each child here today. Amen.**

Sing the Bible Memory Verse Song and other related songs.

OFFERING: Collect the offering.

WORSHIP ILLUSTRATION: *The Adventures of Delbert & Lello* puppet script or storybook

BIBLE MEMORY VERSE: Practice Bible Memory Verse with the motions. “In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.” Genesis 1:1

THE WORD GOD FILLED THE HEAVENS AND THE EARTH CLASSROOM PROMISE

Place the Creation Box in your lap or on a table next to you. **Last time, we learned about the first two days of Creation. Creation is the story of how God made the world. We find it in the Bible. Let’s get out our Creation Box. It helps us remember all the things God made.** Remove the items from the box as you review days 1 & 2.

- The flashlight reminds us of the first day of creation when God created day and night.
- The water bottle reminds us of the second day when God separated the water and the sky.

Today, we will hear about day 3 and day 4. Let’s listen. Handle Bible as a special treasure, leaving it open to Genesis 1:10b.

WATCH THE WORD: GENESIS 1:9-19

Read poem. Display visual.

- **On the first day, God said, “Let there be light!”**
- **On the second day, He made the sky above and the waters below.**
- **God saw it was good and He was right.**
- **On the third day, God made the land and seas.**
- **He filled the land with plants and fruit trees.**
- **God saw it was good and He was right.**
- **On the fourth day, God put the sun in the sky**
- **There it stays with the moon and stars, so we know day from night.**
- **God saw it was good and He was right.**

Remove the toy tree or plant from the Creation Box. **What did God make on the third day?** (Land, seas, plants, and fruit trees.) Remove the sun, moon, and star shapes. **What did God make on the fourth day?** (Sun, moon, stars.)

THE WAY SEE HOW GOOD GOD’S CREATION IS!

CRAFT: Place in Space

GAMES: Pin the Fruit on the Tree, Good for Day or Night

SNACK: Fruit and Seeds

Lesson Aim: To know how God created
the living creatures.

THE WORSHIP THE GOD WHO CREATES

Who made the animals? (God.) **Let's thank God for the animals He made.** Have the children bow their heads and close their eyes. **Dear God, thank You for making animals for us to care for, to enjoy, and to love. Amen.**

Sing the Bible Memory Verse Song and other related songs.

OFFERING: Collect the offering.

WORSHIP ILLUSTRATION: *The Adventures of Delbert & Lello* puppet script or storybook

BIBLE MEMORY VERSE: Practice Bible Memory Verse with the motions. "In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth." Genesis 1:1

THE WORD GOD CREATED LIVING CREATURES CLASSROOM PROMISE

Place the Creation Box near you. **Today, we continue to learn about Creation, the story of how God made the world. We find it in the Bible. Let's get out our Creation Box. It helps us remember all the things God made.** Remove the items from the box as you review days 1-4.

- Flashlight: First day of creation when God created day and night.
- Water: Second day when God separated the water and the sky.

- Plant (or tree): Third day when God made the land, seas, plants, and trees.
- Sun, moon, stars: Fourth Day when God made the sun, moon, and stars.

Today, we will hear about day 5 and day 6. Let's listen. Handle Bible as a special treasure, leaving it open to Genesis 1:21.

WATCH THE WORD: GENESIS 1:20-31

Read poem. Display visual.

- **On the first day, God said, "Let there be light!"**
- **On the second day, He made the sky above and the waters below.**
- **God saw it was good and He was right.**
- **On the third day, God made land and seas, plants and trees.**
- **On the fourth day, God put the sun in the sky with the moon and stars.**
- **God saw it was good and He was right.**
- **On the fifth day, God put birds in the air,**
- **Fish in the sea, and flying things everywhere!**
- **And God saw that it was good.**
- **On the sixth day, God made the creatures on the land,**
- **Wild animals, creeping things, woman, and man.**
- **And God saw that it was good.**

Show the toy fish and bird. **What did God make on the fifth day?** (Birds, flying things, fish.) Show the toy animal and person. **What did God make on the sixth day?** (Animals, people.)

Lesson Aim: To know God created us for relationships with Him
and with one another.

THE WORSHIP THE GOD WHO CREATES

Say hello to each child, calling them by name. If they aren't in the Praise Time area, call them over by name. Point to each child and say, **"You are my friend." God made us to be friends with Him and friends with each other. Let's thank Him for that.** Have the children bow their heads and close their eyes. **Dear God, we are so glad you made us to be friends with You and with each other. Thank You, God. Amen.**

Sing the Bible Memory Verse Song and other related songs.

OFFERING: Collect the offering.

WORSHIP ILLUSTRATION: *The Adventures of Delbert & Lello* puppet script or storybook

BIBLE MEMORY VERSE: Practice Bible Memory Verse with the motions.
"In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth." Genesis 1:1

THE WORD GOD CREATED A FRIEND FOR ADAM CLASSROOM PROMISE

On the first six days of creation, God made all the things in the world. Let's see if you can remember what God made. Remove the items from the box children mention the creations they represent. Give hints as needed.

- Flashlight: First day of creation—God created day and night
- Water: Second day—God separated the water and the sky
- Plant (or tree): Third day—God made land, seas, plants, and trees.

- Sun, moon, stars: Fourth day—God made the sun, moon, and stars.
- Toy fish, bird: Fifth day—God made birds, flying things, and fish.
- Toy animal, toy person: Sixth day—God made animals, creeping things, and people.

Today, we will learn more about the first people God made. Let's listen. Handle Bible as a special treasure, leaving it open to Genesis 2:18.

WATCH THE WORD: GENESIS 1:20-31

Read poem. Display visual.

- **On the first day, God said, "Let there be light!"**
- **On the second day, He made the sky above and the waters below.**
- **God saw it was good and He was right.**
- **On the third day, God made land and seas, plants and trees.**
- **On the fourth day, God put the sun in the sky with the moon and stars.**
- **God saw it was good and He was right.**
- **On the fifth day, God made birds, flying things, and fish.**
- **On the sixth day, God made wild animals, creeping things, woman, and man.**
- **God saw it was good and He was right.**
- **God made Adam to care for the land and to name the animals.**
- **Then, God made a helper named Eve to be Adam's friend.**
- **God saw it was good and He was right.**
- **Just as God created Adam and Eve to be together,**
- **He made us to be friends and help each other.**
- **God saw it was good and He was right.**

THE WORSHIP THE GOD WHO CREATES

Let's pray before we begin praise time. Have the children bow their heads and close their eyes. **Dear God, we praise You for who You are and everything You have done. Amen.**

Sing the Bible Memory Verse Song and other related songs.

OFFERING: Collect the offering.

BIBLE MEMORY VERSE: Practice Bible Memory Verse with the motions. "In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth." Genesis 1:1

THE WORD GOD RESTED CLASSROOM PROMISE

Set out the items from the Creation Box in order. **On the first six days of creation, God made all the things in the world. Let's review what He created on each day.** Point to each item as you review.

- Flashlight: First day of creation when God created day and night.
- Water: Second day—God separated the water and the sky.
- Plant (or tree): Third day—God made land, seas, plants, and trees.
- Sun, moon, stars: Fourth day—God made the sun, moon, and stars.
- Toy fish, bird: Fifth day—God made birds, flying things, and fish.
- Toy animal, toy person: Sixth day—God made animals, creeping things, and people.

Point to the pillow (bean bag). **This pillow (or bean bag) reminds me of what God did on Day 7. Let's find out what that was.** Handle Bible as a special treasure, leaving it open to Genesis 2:3.

WATCH THE WORD: GENESIS 2:1-3

Read poem. Display visual.

- **On the first day, God said, "Let there be light!"**
- **On the second day, He made the sky above and the waters below.**
- **God saw it was good and He was right.**
- **On the third day, God made land and seas, plants and trees.**
- **On the fourth day, God put the sun in the sky with the moon and stars.**
- **God saw it was good and He was right.**
- **On the fifth day, God made birds, flying things, and fish.**
- **On the sixth day, God made wild animals, creeping things, woman, and man.**
- **God saw it was good and He was right.**
- **God's work was done, and on the seventh day He rested.**
- **He made the seventh day holy, after He had blessed it.**
- **God saw it was good and He was right.**

What did God do on the seventh day of the world He had made? (He rested.) **What did He say about everything He created?** (It was good.)
