January 4 (Lesson 25)	Adam and Eve in the Garden, Genesis 2:15-24	God made Adam and Eve and placed them in the Garden of Eden.	To see God created us for specific relationships with Himself and others.
January 11 (Lesson 26)	The Day of Rest, Genesis 2:1-3	God rested. He blessed the Sabbath day and made it holy.	To know why God wants us to rest on the Sabbath.

	Bible Story	What He Has Done	Lesson Aim
January 25 (Lesson 27)	Adam and Eve Sin, Genesis 3:1-6, 8-9, 12-13, 21, 23	God banished Adam and Eve from the garden after they disobeyed Him.	To know how sin came into the world and the choices God provides.
February 1 (Lesson 28)	Cain and Abel, Genesis 4:2b-9	God showed mercy and justice to Cain.	To know God wants our best in our offerings and in our relationships.
February 8 (Lesson 29)	God Saves Noah, Genesis 6:5-9, 14, 19, 22; 7:16-18; 8:1, 6-12; 9:13-15	God provided a way to save Noah and the animals.	To know how and why God saves us. (Salvation Message)
*February 22 (Lesson 30)	The Tower of Babel, Genesis 11:1-9	God scattered the builders of the tower of Babel.	To learn to point to God's greatness instead of our own.
March 1 (Lesson 31)	The Call of Abram, Genesis 12:1-8	God called Abram and promised to bless him.	To know we can trust and obey God's direction.

	Bible Story	What He Has Done	Lesson Aim
March 8 (Lesson 11)	Banishing An Evil Spirit, Luke 4:31-37	Jesus commanded the evil spirit to come out.	To challenge children to privately assess their current relationship with Jesus.
March 15 (Lesson 12)	Raising Lazarus, John 11:3-6, 14-15, 21-27, 32-36, 40-54	Jesus called Lazarus from out of the tomb.	To understand why the story surrounding Lazarus' resurrection impacts all believers as well as Jesus' public ministry.
*March 22 (Lesson 13)	Riding into Jerusalem, Luke 19:28-42	Jesus rode into Jerusalem on a donkey.	To see when Jesus is the Lord of our lives, we can trust Him and give to Him whatever He asks of us.
April 5 (Lesson 14)	The Miracle of Easter, Matthew 27:50-51, 54-66; 28:1-10; John 20:1-9	Jesus died on the cross and God raised Him from the dead.	To consider the eyewitness reports, prophecies, and faith God gives us to see who Jesus is and what He has done for us.
April 12 (Lesson 15)	Appearing on the Shore, John 21:1-14	Jesus appeared on the shore to His followers.	To expect and recognize Jesus' presence and activity in our daily lives.
