	Bible Story	What He Has Done	Lesson Aim
April 26 (Lesson 30)	The Tower of Babel, Genesis 11:1-9	God scattered the builders of the tower of Babel.	To learn to point to God’s greatness instead of our own.
May 3 (Lesson 31)	The Call of Abram, Genesis 12:1-8	God called Abram and promised to bless him.	To know we can trust and obey God’s direction.

	Bible Story	What He Has Done	Lesson Aim
May 10 (Lesson 32)	Abram and Lot, Genesis 13:1-2, 5-18	God gave Abram the land and blessed it.	To learn how to be a peacekeeper.
*May 24 (Lesson 33)	Hagar and Ishmael, Genesis 16:7-16; 21:9-20	God watched over Hagar and Ishmael and gave them a promise.	To see God watches over us and ensures His plans for us.
May 31 (Lesson 34)	Abraham and Isaac, Genesis 22:1-2, 6-18	God fulfilled His promise of a son for Abraham and tested Abraham’s faith.	To challenge children to a more active faith.
June 7 (Lesson 35)	The Search for Rebekah, Genesis 24:34-51	God helped the servant fulfill his mission and find Rebekah.	To challenge children in each job they have been given to obey, pray, and give themselves away.
June 14 (Lesson 36)	Jacob and Esau, Genesis 25:29-33; 27:19-23, 32-36	God had a plan for each brother, Jacob and Esau.	To understand the role of God’s mercy in the lives of those He chooses to use in His plans.
June 21 (Lesson 37)	Life of Jacob: The Blessing, Genesis 32:24-30; 33:4, 8-10; 35:1, 10-12	God kept His promises to be with Jacob and to make him into a nation.	To inspire spiritual growth in pursuing God’s blessings and in mending relationships.
